**Background**

Project Lead The Way is an Engineering Curriculum targeted for middle and high school students designed to interest and prepare students for careers in engineering and high-technology fields. Abingdon, ROWVA and Knoxville community unit school districts plan to partner with Carl Sandburg College such that CSC provide two PLTW courses, Digital Electronics and Computer Integrated Manufacturing beginning in fall 2007. This program provides the opportunity to further partner with K-12 districts to deliver quality high-tech curriculum.

In February 2007, Carl Sandburg College received the Project Lead They Way 2007-2008 agreement for signature. The document has been reviewed by legal counsel. Additionally, the PLTW agreement requires approval by the Board of Trustees of Carl Sandburg College.

**Recommended Action**

The Administration recommends entering an agreement with Project Lead They Way for the 2007-2008 academic year.
