Item 5.8 Employment of Full-Time Mathematics and Physics Instructor

Institutional Focal Points/Goals

Background

Due to the vacancy created by Mr. Norm Gross' retirement, the College advertised the position internally and externally, per college policy, attracting six applicants. A committee consisting of Mr. Larry Benne, Vice President of Academic Services; Dr. Lori Sundberg, Vice President of Administrative Services; Mr. Darrell Clevidence, Associate Dean of Math and Natural Sciences; and Mr. Norm Gross, full-time Physics and Mathematics instructor; interviewed two candidates. The committee recommends the employment of Mr. Robert Hendrickson.

Mr. Hendrickson earned his Bachelors (1968) and Masters (1988) Degrees in Physics from Western Illinois University. He has taken numerous other graduate credits in Mathematics and Physics from Western Illinois and other Universities. Mr. Hendrickson has taught for over thirty years in public school systems in the areas of Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, and Engineering. He has been an adjunct instructor at Carl Sandburg College in Physics and Mathematics for thirty-four semesters since 1982.

Recommended Action

The Administration recommends the Board of Trustees authorize the employment of Mr. Robert Hendrickson, Full-Time Physics and Mathematics Instructor (union eligible), reflecting a Masters Degree, plus Forty-five Semester Hours, (MA+45), Address 8, at an annual salary of \$44,080, effective July 1, 2007.
