Item 10.1 Employment of Full-Time Chemistry Instructor

Institutional Focal Points/Goals

Background

Due to the vacancy created by Mr. Larry Ancelet's retirement, the College advertised the position per college policy, attracting ten applicants. A committee consisting of Mr. Larry Benne, Vice President of Academic Services; Dr. Lori Sundberg, Vice President of Administrative Services; Mr. Darrell Clevidence, Associate Dean of Math and Natural Sciences; and Ms. Marjorie Smolensky, Biology Instructor; interviewed four candidates. The committee recommends the employment of Dr. Nibedita Sanyal.

Dr. Sanyal earned her Bachelor's Degree in Chemistry from the University of Calcutta, India, her Master's Degree in Chemistry from the Indian Institute of Technology in Kanpur, India. She earned her Doctorate in Chemistry from the University of Massachusetts in the United States. Dr. Sanyal has been a Laboratory Assistant Instructor during all of her graduate work. She has also conducted research in chemistry in both India and the United States, plus has participated in seven scientific publications.

Recommended Action

The Administration recommends the Board of Trustees authorize the employment of Dr. Nibedita Sanyal, Full-Time Chemistry Instructor (union eligible), reflecting a Doctorate Degree, Address 2, at an annual salary of \$40,260, effective July 1, 2007.
