

WIA DUAL CREDIT PROGRAM AGREEMENT
For the 2007-2008 Academic Year

This **Agreement** is made and entered into by and between **Workforce Investment Office of Western Illinois**, hereinafter referred to as the "**Grant Recipient**", and **Carl Sandburg College**, hereinafter referred to as the "**Training Provider**". This agreement applies to the WIA Dual Credit Program funded by the Grant Recipient described as follows:

The WIA Dual Credit Program is offered to WIA eligible high school seniors. Youth seeking assistance with expenses for dual credit courses must meet WIA income eligibility guidelines to qualify for this program. Dual credit courses eligible for WIA funding must lead to a vocational certification. The training provider will provide the Grant Recipient with an ongoing, updated listing of its dual credit course offerings. WIA will not pay for courses that are already funded by the local school districts. Approved dual credit program participants are eligible to receive WIA funds for books, tuition, and supplies.

The eligibility information provided at the time of the original application to the WIA youth program will remain in effect, even if income circumstances change.

The Parties agree as follows:

1. The Grant Recipient will pay the Training Provider for the tuition costs of the WIA eligible youth participant's dual credit course. The Training Provider will accept WIA authorization for each participant's tuition cost and ensure that they will not be purged from the registration list should actual payment be received after the publicized cut off date.
2. The Grant Recipient will provide the Training Provider with timely lists of students funded by WIA dual credit, pay for costs and notify the Training Provider if a student is exited or has been denied further funding.
3. Providing all financial obligations to The Training Provider have been met, The Training Provider will make available to the Grant Recipient the grades obtained by dual credit participants and provide timely notice of student withdrawal/completion of WIA-funded courses.
