Item 7.1 Termination of Bright Futures Employees

Focal Points and Goals

Background

The Bright Futures program provides child care and parenting resources, pre-K classrooms, a lending library, and training for local child care providers through five grants: Child Care Resource and Referral Grant, Prevention Initiative Grant, Partners in Parenting Grant, Bright Futures Grant and the Pre-K Grant. Carl Sandburg College provides employment for three full-time, benefited positions and three hourly positions in the Bright Futures Program.

Community Unit School District # 205 (CUSD #205) is the fiscal agent for the Bright Futures grants with the aforementioned positions reporting to a CUSD #205 supervisor. The Bright Futures program is housed at the CUSD #205 Administration building and the work schedule is based upon the CUSD #205 calendar. Carl Sandburg College and CUSD #205 agree that beginning September 1, 2007, CUSD# 205 will be the employer of record for Bright Futures Program employees.

Recommended Action

The Administration recommends termination of three full-time Bright Futures employees: Ms. Kathleen Cecil, Ms. Roxanne Christianson, and Ms. Ruby Hughs effective August 31, 2007.
