Item 5.1 Employment of Full-Time Sociology Instructor

Focal Points and Goals

Background

With the recent retirement of the College's Full-time Sociology Instructor, the College advertised to fill the vacancy. Twenty-four applicants were received for the position. A committee consisting of Mr. Wendel Hunigan, Sociology Professor; Mr. James Graham, Associate Dean of Social and Behavioral Sciences; and Dr. Lori Sundberg, Vice President of Academic Services; interviewed three candidates. The committee recommends the employment of Mr. Gary Douglas for the Sociology teaching position.

Mr. Douglas possesses a Master's degree in Sociology as well as a Master's Degree in Law Enforcement & Justice Administration. He has been teaching with Carl Sandburg College in an adjunct position since 2004 in both sociology and criminal justice. Mr. Douglas has also taught Sociology for Blackhawk College.

Recommended Action

The Administration recommends the Board of Trustees authorize the employment of Mr. Gary Douglas, full-time tenure-track Sociology instructor (union eligible), reflecting a Masters Degree, Address two, at an annual salary of \$36,920, effective July 1, 2008.
