Item 5.2 Employment of Full-Time Economics/Business Administration Instructor

Background

With the recent vacancy of the College's Full-time Economics/Business instructor, the College advertised to fill the vacancy. Twenty-seven applicants were received for the position. A committee consisting of Mr. Mark Pfeigler, Dean of Occupational Programs; Mr. James Graham, Associate Dean of Social and Behavioral Sciences; and Dr. Lori Sundberg, Vice President of Academic Services; interviewed four candidates. The committee recommends the employment of Ms. Kelli Mayes-Denker for the Economics/Business teaching position.

Ms. Mayes-Denker possesses a Bachelor's degree in Economics and a Master's degree in Economics. She earned both her Bachelor of Arts and Master of Arts in Economics from Eastern Illinois University where she also earned a minor in Business Administration. In her most recent capacity, she was a Marketing Analyst and Trainer with Marketing Solutions Group, Inc where she provided training to groups both in person and online.

Recommended Action

The Administration recommends the Board of Trustees authorize the employment of Ms. Kelli Mayes-Denker for a full-time tenure-track Economics/Business Administration instructor (union eligible), reflecting a Masters Degree, Address zero, at an annual salary of \$35,520, effective July 1, 2008.
