

The Carl Sandburg College Food Service Program is operated for the benefit of College personnel and the community in general. The principal thrust of the program is to provide food service to students and to staff at a reasonable price within the parameters of cost of materials and labor with a small profit margin.

The Food Service Program will provide a varied menu within the capabilities of the equipment and space.

The Program is available to members of the community at large. Special solicitation of participants is not encouraged, because it shall not be the policy or practice of the College to compete with private enterprise. The Food Service will be expected to provide meals to groups which can be served as a part of the facilities use policy. Special groups may be served from time to time which may enhance the community relations image of the College or promote the general program of the College. All meals served under the provision of the facilities use policy or to special groups will be served at cost plus a small margin of profit, and menus will be within the limitation of the facilities and personnel available to the Program.
